## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED

- 1. THAT the period of Statutory Management of Concord Insurance Company Limited which had been placed under Statutory Management be extended from the 9th April, 2016 and until such period that the Winding Up Petition filed in court on 4th March 2016 under Winding Up Cause Number 6 of 2016 is finally heard and determined.
- 2. THAT there be a stay of all proceedings subsisting against Concord Insurance Company Limited (Under Statutory Management) during the currency of the Moratorium declared by the Statutory Manager on 6th February 2013 and as extended severally the latest being on the 9th October 2015 for a further 6 months.
- 3. THAT the running time for the purposes of any law of limitation in respect of any notice, demand or claim by any policy holders or creditors of Concord Insurance Company Limited (under Statutory Management) is suspended and shall remain suspended during the currency of the moratorium declared by the Statutory Manager.
